NARRATIVE:
 On Saturday, July 21, 2018, at 0017hrs while I Deputy Cedric Lampkin was on patrol, I was dispatched to a welfare call at 25682 W Hwy 72. Cencom advised me the RP stated there was a man laying down in the road. Cencom then stated the RP said he looked like he was drunk.

Once on scene, I observed a white male later identified as Darrell Philpott W/M DOB 2/16/1961 was laying on the side of W Hwy 72 with his legs in the westbound lane. When I approached Darrell, I could see a liquor bottle next to his head. I asked him was he ok and could he stand. He stated he was drunk and just wanted to go to jail. I noticed he had open cuts on his face do to him falling so I had Cencom send in the medics. While the medics was trying to put him in the ambulance he could not stand without help so they put him on the bed. Darrell continued to say take him to jail and wouldn't let the medics transport him do to his condition.

The medics advised me because of Darrell was trying to fight them they couldn't transport him. I advised Cencom and placed him under arrest after the medics cleared him. While placing handcuffs on Darrell began to resist me doing so. Darrell stated he was going to kill me for putting cuffs on him. When I placed Darrell in my unit he became more upset and said just kill me.

I advised Cencom I was in route to the jail and to notify them he was combative. While in route Darrell hit his head up against the windows of the unit and was trying to kick it out. Darrell continued making statements that he was going to hurt me and anyone else. When we arrived at the jail he was charged with 5-71-102 Public intox and 5- 54-102 obstruction governmental operations.

Darrell was then turned over to the intake deputy.
